We are very pleased to announce that First Presbyterian Church will be offering an After School Care Program beginning in August of 2010 for children in Kindergarten through Fifth Grade. The After School Program at First Presbyterian Church is designed to provide a premium curriculum in a safe, loving and caring Christian environment. Our daily schedule will include: healthy snack time, homework time, fitness fun, Christian education, fine arts and technology.

If you are interested in participating in this program, please complete the attached questionnaire no later than Friday, July 2, 2010. Our goal is to attract a minimum of 20 students per day for us to make this program a reality. Please feel free to share this with anyone you think may be interested.

Our program will operate from 2:45 p.m. through 6:00 p.m. and will follow the Polk County School Calendar. Our goal is to provide transportation from schools in our area. Our program will offer the flexibility of enrolling your child from one to five days a week and pay only for those days attended. The daily rate is \$14.00 per day and \$12.00 per day for siblings. Payments will be prepaid monthly. If your child is enrolled 5 days a week, a 10 percent discount will be offered. There is a \$50 registration fee and a \$25 supply fee which will be due on August 2.

We are eager to expand our Children's Ministry to enrich children and families in our church and in our community. We will contact you by July 16, to let you know if we had adequate response to proceed with this program.
